

The University of Akron School of Law Career Services Office Federal Judicial Clerkships Information Sheet (Post-Graduate Positions)

The following information is provided to students as an introduction to the application process for federal clerkships. Please inform the Career Services Office if you are interested in federal or state clerkships so we may work together in identifying potential clerkships and as you draft your application materials.

The Administrative Office of the Federal Courts has an online application resource called OSCAR (Online System for Clerkship Application & Review) where federal judges post information regarding their open law clerk or staff attorney positions and where applicants may apply for these positions. Additional detailed information about the application process can be found on OSCAR (www.oscar.uscourts.gov).

Judicial clerkship applicants must be proactive in their pursuit of a clerkship. Information on OSCAR may be updated at any time as needed by judges, so students should either check
