Women as Constitution Makers: Revisiting the 19th A after Dobbs

Paula A. Monopoli is the Sol & Carlyn Hubert Professor of Law at the University of Maryland CareySchool of Law. She is the author of Constitutional Orphan: Gender Equality & the Nineteenth Amendment (Oxford University Press 202,0) ender and Constitutional Design, in the Yale Law Journal, and Situating Dobb & Akron Law's ConLawNOW

In this talk, Prof Monopoli revisits the 19th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution in light of the Supreme Court's 2022 decision in Dobbs She argusthat the 19th Amendment should be understood as an amendment that speaks both to the nation's rejection of a monosexual democracy and its affirmation that matters which implicate women's autonomy as citizens are properly within the purview of the national government as a matter of federalism.
